Greetings Pastor:

The North Carolina COGOP Board of Directors, and Convention Committee extend to you the blessings of Grace and Peace from God the Father of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Our prayer is that the Peace and Grace of God is with you here on Earth as it is in Heaven.

Pastor, this memo serves as a reminder regarding the approved Policy and State Convention action as it pertains to having "Adequate and Appropriate Insurance Coverage" for your local church. Following, you will find the policy statement and corresponding actions that are required in the policy for all NCCOGOP Pastors and Churches. This policy was approved by the Finance Committee, Convention Executive Committee, North American Presbyters Office, Legal Counsel, the 2019 State Convention and NCCOGOP Board of Directors.

**Policy Statement:** *All North Carolina Church of God of Prophecy churches will be appropriately and adequately insured at all times.*

You will find in section six that the policy provides a timeline for corresponding action of each pastor and local church for implementation and certification. A paraphrase of section six states;

We hereby resolve that this policy statement from the State Board of Directors, is adopted and effective, and is to be implemented at all local churches, to wit:

- *that on August 1, 2019 all appointed pastors will have 90 days (i.e., until October 29, 2019) to authenticate to the State Office that the local church has the appropriate type(s) and the adequate amount(s) of insurance coverage.*

Pastor; attached to this memo is a complete copy of the Board approved policy for your review so that you can determine the amount of insurance required to adequately protect the church. Moreover, this memo is written to remind you that a copy of the Proof of Insurance or Certificate of Insurance is due into the NCCOGOP State Office on or before **November 1, 2019**.
